- 3. Motion by Fisher, 2nd by Webster to approve meeting agenda. Ayes: All. Nays: None. Motion carried.
- 4. Motion by Kulm, 2nd by Chartier to approve April 10, 2018 Planning Commission meeting minutes with the correction requested by Fisher changing his vote from approve to abstain on the agenda item approving the December 12, 2017 minutes. Ayes: Chartier, Opitz, Webster, Kulm. Nays: Fisher. Motion Carried.
- 5. Public Hearings
 - A. Motion by Webster, 2nd by Fisher to open public hearing to consider a conditional use permit extension filed by Silex Group, LLC, applicant, and Clarence O. Keyes, Trustee of Clarence O. Keyes Living Trust, property owner, for a concrete recycling and distribution plant to be located on property zoned Agriculture Residential and legally described as the Northeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of Section 11, Township 13 North, Range 11 East of the 6th P.M., Sarpy County, Nebraska, and generally located on the southwest corner of Capehart Road and Highway 50. Joe Dethlefs, engineer with Thompson, Dressen & Dorner, Inc., representing Silex Group, LLC, requested an extension to the current Conditional Use Permit which will expire June 2018. Dethlefs stated unforeseen circumstances have caused issues with their proposed new location forcing Silex Group to pursue different site options for the business. New property has been established and the anticipated relocation time frame will be September to October 2018. The new site is just north of Insurance Auto Auction.

Opitz inquired as to when Silex Group became aware of problems with their proposed new location forcing the delay. Dethlefs stated that two months ago the City of Papillion expressed concern with the planned location north of the Sarpy County Landfill. Sarpy County originally approved the new conditional use permit for Silex; however, the City of Papillion took over jurisdiction of the new site upon their recent annexation.

Kathleen Gottsch, City Administrator, stated city staff will review the conditional use permit for the new site.

Gottsch stated that Paul Caudill, an existing neighbor near Silex's present location, expressed concern regarding the extension of the Conditional Use Permit.

No further questions or comments were made. Motion by Webster, 2nd by Kulm to close the public hearing. Ayes: All. Nays: None. Motion carried. Public hearing closed at 7:18 p.m.
